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I enjoy making individual desserts like mousses and puddings, but the problem I always run into is transporting the individual cups in and out of the refrigerator: I either have to grab them one at a time or watch them slide around when I use a tray or cookie sheet. I discovered that my large muffin tin works perfectly to hold the six 6-ounce cups I serve the dessert in. There's no more sliding around, and it's easy to bring them all to the table at once.


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
